ROUTE DIRECTION

The College is approachable –

- From Pune Railway Station to College is just 12 Kms away and 17 Kms from Pune Airport.

- Catch a Bus from Pune Railway station for SWARGATE and again catch a Bus for KATRAJ and get down at Main Gate of **Bharati Vidyapeeth University (Dhankawadi Campus)** and ask for the College OR
- Catch an AUTO RICKSHAW from Pune Railway station to **Bharati Vidyapeeth University (Dhankawadi Campus, Pune-Satara Road)** and ask for the College.

N.B.-

- Rs. 12,000/- (includes refundable caution and library deposit of Rs.2000/-) will be charged extra during the course for track suit, intramural kits, camp, picnic, educational tour etc. Outstanding dues, if any, may be recovered from the caution/ library deposit amount.
- 20% seats are reserved for **management quota** and/or for **foreign students**.
- Fees must be **deposited directly in the Bank account of our College** through prescribed Bank slip (available with the office accountant/ clerk) as specified for different courses. **Students shall not pay any cash amount to any staff** without the permission from the Principal and **must take receipt** from the concerned person. All the transaction shall be made through bank accounts only.
- Donation, in any kind, is not accepted – **please note**.

SERVICE / JOB OPPORTUNITY

The College provides guidance so that **the 100% of our students get a job / service** through its **placement cell**. Till date, all of our students are in job / or in service with good salary package.

HOW TO APPLY?

- 1) Download **prescribed** application form & prospectus from our website: www.bvuphysicaleducation.com
- 2) Fill its all columns in CAPITAL LETTERS with **your own hand writing** and put **signature** of guardian, medical officer (with seal) and also yours in the prescribed format - wherever deemed necessary.
- 3) Paste **one passport size photo** on the application form and **attach two extra photos** with the application.
- 4) Attach attested copy of the **documents: date of birth, supportive educational qualification etc.**
- 5) **PROCESSING FEE:** Attach a **DD** of Rs.2000/- (non-refundable fee; see the column "**Last Date for Application & Late fees**" in this prospectus for late fee) that shall be purchased from a **nationalized bank** in favour of the **Principal, BVDU College of Physical Education, payable at PUNE**.

- 6) Send duly filled application along with all the above documents by registered post/ speed post to the **Principal, Bharati Vidyapeeth University's College of Physical Education, DHANKAWADI (At + P.O.), Pune-411 043 (Maharashtra, India).**
- 7) Any physical deformity or problem regarding medical fitness notices during the training period may result in discharging the students from the College.

Last Date for Application & Late fees

The processing fee, as given below, is non-refundable. A *DD* of the **Processing fee** is to be purchased *from a nationalized bank in favour of the Principal, BVDU College of Physical Education, payable at PUNE* must be enclosed with the duly filled prescribed application form:

Up to 20th June, the processing fee is only 2000/-.

Up to 25th June, the processing fee is 2000/- + late fee of 500/- = 2500/-.

Up to 5th July, the processing fee is 2000/- + super late fee 1000/- = 3000/-.

If the duly filled application is **submitted by hand**, the above processing fee amount may directly be deposited in the Bank A/c of our College by filling a Bank Chalan (available in our College office). In this case, there is no need to purchase a DD.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

A) For admission to the Regular Courses:

- Candidates belong to other states (out of Maharashtra) must come with **all preparations** (i.e., *luggage including bedding, necessary things, extra dresses, track suit, half pant, sports shoes, banyan, extra lock-key, umbrella, original certificates & mark sheets, date of birth proof, money for hostel & food, and fees for admission etc*) during **Admission test** or during **Common Entrance Test (CET)** for admission. **Because immediately after admission-test, the regular classes for the selected students will be started on the very next day.** Thus, the selected students **will not be allowed to go home** for the above preparation immediately after admission test – *please note.*
- Every candidate has to appear for a **Common Entrance Test (CET) of 100 marks** that consist of a **written test** (40 Marks), a **physical fitness test** (40 Marks) and **oral interview** (20 Marks). The details of the CET are as follows:

- The candidates will have to **bring all original certificates for verification** along with one-set of Xerox copy at the time of **admission test or CET**.
- On the basis of the results of the **Common Entrance Tests (CET)** of 100 marks, a **merit list of selected students** and also a **waiting list** will be displayed on the **next working day** at 5:00 p.m.
- The College reserves the right to **deny admission** to a candidate on the disciplinary grounds.
- *20% seats are reserved for management quota and/or for foreign students.*

Filling ANTI-RAGGING FORM & Payment of Fees

- Yearly Fees can be paid in full or in 2 installments (i.e., 1st installment during admission and 2nd installment after Diwali vacation).
- As per the merit list, at first, the candidates must fill the ANTI-RAGGING FORM and submit it to the office of the Principal. And then they will be allowed to take admission by paying fees in full or in installment **within 2 days**. If fails, the seats will be filled by the students from the **waiting list**. However, the waiting-listed students may be given chance to take admission on **management quota**.
- **Non-payment of fees** within the above stated period will automatically cancel the candidate's name from admission and the waiting listed students will be given a chance for admission

B) For admission to the Vacation Courses (if any):

Eligible candidates will be given direct admission on **first come first serve basis**.

AWARDS/ SCHOLARSHIP

Following awards and scholarship are provided to our students:

- Sports Achievement (5 marks are added in the university's final examination).
- All the Indian State Governments provide scholarship to the meritorious as well as educationally backward and / or minority students like SC/ ST/ NT etc.

JOB / SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

Direct appointments for services are provided to our students through CAMPUS INTERVIEW conducted by *renowned educational institutes (schools, colleges & universities), educational organization/consultancies, hotels, corporate sectors and fitness clubs* etc in India and Abroad. **100% students get job.** Students who have good communication skill in English get preference for the job. Therefore, try to develop this skill.

HOSTEL FACILITY

- Separate rented hostel facility for boys and girls is available near the campus.
- Seats in hostel are available on first come first serve basis.
- Lodging charges are affordable for the middle class and/ or economically poor students.

RULES OF ATTENDANCE, CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

ATTENDANCE

- Punctuality and Regularity in **attendance** (90% for theory classes and 90% for practical classes at play ground) is a must and will be strictly enforced. Students will not be allowed to *sit for* the University's final examination in case of shortage in attendance i.e., if overall attendance is less than 90%.
- Absent either in a theory class or in a practical class will be considered as absent for the full day. It is the responsibility of the student to contact professor concerned and find out the status of his/ her attendance periodically or any other rules made by the College.
- **Attendance** on the opening day and closing day of the College is also **compulsory**. Attendance is compulsory on national festivals, like Independence Day, Sports day, Teacher's day etc. Attendance in all the examinations (including internal exams, tutorial), intramural and extramural programmes, and practice teaching days of the College is compulsory. Moreover, attendance in all the functions and activities of the College in a disciplined manner is **compulsory** – *please note*. If fails, the name of students will be removed from the College roll.
- **Remaining absent without permission** from the principal will be liable to charge 100/- per day.

CODE OF CONDUCT & DISCIPLINE

- Ours is a RAGGING FREE institution. Ragging or harassment or misbehavior or comments regarding caste or torturing the students of other states and in-state or violence or misleading act of any kind or using threats language etc is a serious offence and will be dealt very STRICTLY as per LAW and is liable for punishment – **either cancelation of studentship and/ or penalty**. Prior to get admission, a student/ guardian must give an UNDERTAKING regarding RAGGING as per UGC rules.
- **Late arrival** in a class or college will also be treated as absent and is liable to pay the fine amount 100/-. All the students must arrive at least 5 minutes prior to a class and shall attend all the classes regularly.
- **Leave without permission** from the Principal, will be charged with a penalty 100/- per day. *If a student remains absent for more than 02 days in any class (theory or practical), without such permission, will be removed from the rolls of the College.* Such students will have to seek fresh term at the beginning of the next academic year. *Decision of the Principal is final whether to sanction a leave or not.*
- **Notice-board** should be read on arrival and departure and the instructions thereon should be followed strictly.
- Students must bring **pen and notebooks** when they come for a class.
- Students must spend their leisure in the **library**. If library books, journals, magazines etc are damaged or lost, the students must pay double the actual price. In case of damage or lost of foreign-authored books or out of print books, the punishable amount will be decided by the Principal. Borrowed books are to be returned in time and breaking this rule is liable to punishment.
- **While talking** to teachers, avoid hands in pockets (or on waist), twirling the moustache, sneezing loudly, yawning, shouting or disturbing classes with loud conversation and these come under the category of indiscipline behavior.
- Behave respectfully with senior students and treat your junior students with affection and gentleness.
- Damage to movable and immovable property of the College, stealing habit, sexual harassment etc will be dealt with as a breach of discipline and will be considered as a punishable offence.

- **Chewing** betel-leaf or tobacco (Gutkha) and spitting or smoking or carrying weapons, or attending class by drinking alcohol and/or using narcotics etc. are prohibited in the college.
- Keep the College campus clean including bathroom and maintain personal hygiene; Hair and nails should be cut regularly. Wear clean dress. Students must not write on blackboard and not disfigure walls, tables *or* benches.

OTHER RULES

- Always remember that you are the representative of this College within and outside the campus. Therefore, observe discipline any where you move. Always carry your College identity card.
- Knowledge of English is preferred, although the mode of instruction and writing examination is in English/ Hindi/ Marathi.
- Use of mobile phones in the College campus is strictly prohibited. If carried, the mobile must be on switch off mode otherwise it will be confiscated.

Examination

- Annual (yearly) examination is taken for M.Phil and D.Y.Ed (Diploma in Yoga Education). Courses.
- Semester (six monthly) examination is taken for B.A. (Phy.Edu), B.P.Ed & M.P.Ed. Courses.
- An eligible student shall fill up the UNIVERSITY EXAM FORM in time.
- A student can write examination in English/ Hindi/ Marathi.

Eligibility to appear for final examination, if a student has -

- 90% attendance in theory and 90% in practical separately.
- Paid all the required fees of the college, and
- Passed in all the internal examinations.
